

## Learner Perception Survey Questions.

Students will respond to each of the statements by selecting one of the four responses.

**Strongly disagree (1) – Disagree (2) – Agree (3) – Strongly agree (4)**

<b>Care</b>
The teacher understands and gets on well with the students in their class
The teacher listens to and respect what their students say
The students listen to and respect what their teachers say
There is a positive learning environment in this class, where I feel supported, happy and confident in my learning
The teacher endeavours to know the background of each student and their learning style
<b>Control</b>
We are always on task and I am rarely distracted in class
<b>Clarify</b>
Explanation is given by the teacher as to what will be achieved by the end of the lesson
The teacher gives me feedback and comments that help improve my learning
The teacher sometimes changes what we do when it is clear we don't understand or need more time or help to learn
<b>Challenge</b>
The things we do in class encourage us to think and ask questions
We use technology in ways that support my learning
Study / Homework tasks are clearly stated at the end of the lesson and what is expected of us by the next lesson
<b>Captivate</b>
In our class we do different types of activities to help us learn in different ways
The teacher introduces new work by finding out what we know and what we can do
<b>Confer</b>
We are encouraged to express our ideas and opinions in class discussions
The teacher provides regular opportunities for positive conversations for learning in class
<b>Consolidate</b>
We often link our learning to current events and issues to consolidate our learning
The teacher revises what was learnt from our previous lesson at the start of the following lesson
The teacher checks to make sure we understand what s/he is teaching us
