### **2025 UNIFORM FITTINGS FOR NEW STUDENTS**

As official school uniform supplier, Noone will be offering new student uniform fitting appointments for St Ignatius College Geelong at the Noone Bellarine store commencing 28<sup>th</sup> October through to the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024.

#### **Campus Shop Trading Hours – 28/10, 30/10, 11/11, 13/11**

We operate an online booking calendar for all uniform fitting appointments, and parents and carers can access this calendar via the Noone website. One booking time required for each student.

We highly recommend that you make an appointment so we can provide you with a personalised fitting service. Full uniform will be available for immediate purchase, or you are welcome to use our lay-by service and collect your order prior to the start of Term 1 2025.

If you already know the sizes you require and don't need fitting assistance, you can visit the store during opening hours, or you can go ahead and order your new uniform via the school online store on our website. You can use Click and Collect from the store or post to home.

**Please do not leave your uniform purchase until just before school commences in 2025. You may experience a long wait time and delays in purchasing your uniform.**

#### **Please follow these instructions to book a uniform fitting appointment:**

1. Go to [Noone.com.au](https://noone.com.au) and find St Ignatius College. Click on the Store Info button.

2. You will be taken the store page. Click '**BOOK AN APPOINTMENT**' button
3. Use the calendar to click on a date you like. Choose a time and complete the booking information.  
**Name required is student name. Only one appointment per student.**
4. Click the '**BOOK APPOINTMENT**' button when you have finished.
5. You will be notified of your booking request, and you will receive email confirmation before the time of the appointment (please also check your 'junk' mail).

Our experienced staff fit for growing room. However, if for any reason the student grows significantly over the summer holiday period, we will happily exchange any uniform item that hasn't been worn and has the tags attached. Methods of payment available are cash, eftpos, visa and mastercard.

# Uniform Requirements



## Summer Uniform

- White striped open neck short sleeve shirt with school logo
- Navy blazer with school logo
- Grey melange short
- Grey/Red/Navy/White anklet sock
- Black lace up shoe - leather heeled shoe (polishable)

Or

- Navy/Red/White striped dress
- Navy blazer with school logo
- White with Navy/Red stripe school socks.
- Black lace up shoe - leather heeled shoe (polishable)

Or

- White striped open neck short sleeve shirt relaxed or tapered fit
- Charcoal shorts worn with blazer and black lace up shoes
- White with Navy/Red stripe school socks.



- Any of the above must be worn with black leather lace-up shoes

# Uniform Requirements



## Winter Uniform

- White striped closed neck long sleeve shirt with school logo
- Navy/Red striped tie
- Red woollen pullover
- Navy blazer with school logo
- Grey/Red/Navy/White ankle sock
- Black lace up shoe - leather heeled shoe (polishable)

Or

- Navy/Red striped winter skirt
- White striped St Ignatius closed neck Long Sleeve shirt with school logo
- Navy tight or navy knee high sock
- Red woollen pullover
- Navy blazer with school logo
- Black lace up shoe - leather heeled shoe (polishable)

Or

- White striped St Ignatius closed neck Long Sleeve shirt with school logo
- Navy tight or navy knee high sock
- Red woollen pullover
- Navy blazer with school logo
- Black lace up shoe - leather heeled shoe (polishable)
- Charcoal slacks (worn with all of the above items)





## Winter Jacket

- To be worn over blazer or over sports uniform only.



## Accessories

- Grey Striped Summer/Winter sock
- White striped Summer sock
- Navy Tights or Navy knee high for winter



- Navy school bag with school logo

- Cap or Bucket Hat



# Sports Uniform



- House Sports Polo top – Gold /Red/Green/Blue houses both in Short Sleeve and Long Sleeve options
- Softshell Sports Jacket – Navy with Red Piping and School logo, both water proof and polar fleece lined
- Sports Rugby top – Navy/Red/White Poly Cotton Rugby with Logo
- Sport Short – Available in 2 lengths – Short and Long – Ink Navy Stretch Microfibre with school logo
- Sport Track pant – Poly Cotton Nylon tapered leg with elastic cuff and school logo
- Sport Sock – White/red with Navy cushion foot
- Bathers – Jammers/Racer back Bather and Rash Vest (optional)



# Uniform Policy

## 2024 Uniform Regulations

The College expects that students should always be well groomed and neatly presented in full school uniform. The uniform should be well maintained i.e. winter shirt tucked in, top button done up, shoes polished and in good repair and ties to be tied correctly.

Each student is required to have full summer, winter and sports uniform. Dress and winter skitt lengths need to be at or below knee height.

The requirements listed below are not exhaustive and may be subject to change. The Principal and/or Deputy Principals will be the final arbiters on all matters of contention and will make other determinations throughout the year as to what is acceptable and appropriate as fashions and styles change.

### Notes:

If for unforeseen circumstances a student is not in full uniform, a written, signed and dated note from a parent/carer must be presented to the Mentor teacher. Such issues are expected to be resolved within one week from the presentation of the note.

Bellarine Uniforms is the sole supplier of Saint Ignatius College Geelong (SICG) uniforms. Please check Noone opening hours at the onsite Noone Uniform shop.

### Blazer

The blazer will be required on some excursions and formal occasions in Terms 1 and 4. To be worn as the outer garment to and from school in Terms 2 and 3. Students riding to school are not required to wear a blazer.

### Outer Garment

The school jumper is never to be worn as the outer garment to and from school. The blazer is to be worn as the outer garment if students require more warmth in Terms 1 and 4.

### School Hat

Is compulsory during lunch and recess in Terms 1 and 4. The cap or bucket hat can be worn in sports/P.E. classes.

### School Bags

SICG logo backpack.

### Labeling

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with the student's full name.

### Sports Uniform

The sports uniform may be worn for Physical Education, Drama and Dance.

### Uniform Changeover Times:

Summer Uniform: Terms 1 and 4 Winter Uniform: Terms 2 and 3

There is a 'changeover' period of two weeks when students may choose to wear either uniform i.e.: first two weeks of Term 2 and first two weeks of Term 4. Students are not permitted to wear a combination of both.

**Jewellery:** The only acceptable pieces of jewellery to be worn are: a wristwatch, one plain gold or silver sleeper (must be smaller than a 5 cent piece), one plain gold or silver stud or white pearl in each earlobe. Visible chains, cords, necklaces, bracelets or rings are not acceptable. No other jewellery is to be worn. Only one piercing in each ear lobe is permitted.

**Piercing:** No facial piercing in any form is acceptable. This includes tongue piercing. Clear piercings/bandaids are not permitted. Any student with inappropriate piercings will be requested to remove them; if unable to do so they will be sent home until the piercing has been removed.

Tattoos are not allowed to be visible whilst in school uniform.

**Cosmetics:** Make-up including fake tan applications are not permitted. Only clear nail polish on natural nails is to be worn. Shellac is not acceptable.

**Hairstyles** are to be simple and neat at all times. Extreme or highly visible bright unnatural colours are not acceptable. If a student presents to school with an extreme hair colour/cut they will be sent home until it is rectified. Long hair (shoulder length) must be tied back in a full pony tail. Hair extensions are not permitted. Hair must not be over the face and eyes. Undercuts are not acceptable. Depending on a student's type of hair, some students may be asked to tie their hair back even if it is not down to their shoulders.

**Undergarments:** No undergarments are to be visible while wearing school uniform.

**Clean-Shaven:** Male students must be clean-shaven at all times.

Beanies: No beanies are to be worn at, or to and from school.





## Xavier

St Francis Xavier (1506-1552) was a revered Spanish Jesuit missionary and one of the most influential figures in the history of Christian missions. Known for his unwavering commitment to spreading Christianity, he played a pivotal role in the early Jesuit missions to Asia, particularly in India, Japan, and the East Indies. His tireless efforts to evangelize and provide spiritual guidance to those he encountered earned him the title "Apostle of the Indies." St Francis Xavier's missionary journeys covered vast distances, and he is remembered for his deep faith, humanitarian work, and the thousands he baptised into the Christian faith. His legacy continues to inspire countless individuals dedicated to serving others and sharing their faith around the world.



## Glowrey

Mary Glowrey (1887-1957), was an Australian medical doctor and devoted missionary, who made significant healthcare contributions in India. As Sister Mary of the Sacred Heart, she belonged to the Sisters of the Society of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Founding the Catholic Health Association of India, she established vital medical services, especially for women and children, showcasing the fusion of medical expertise, compassion, and spirituality. Her enduring legacy continues to inspire healthcare professionals and missionaries, highlighting the transformative impact of her work.

# Our School Houses



## Ricci

Mateo Ricci (1552-1610), an Italian Jesuit missionary, is celebrated for his extraordinary contributions to cultural exchange during the Ming Dynasty in China. Through his profound understanding of Chinese culture and language, he successfully introduced Western knowledge, including science and Christianity, to the Chinese people, employing innovative methods such as a Romanization system for Chinese characters that facilitated communication. Ricci's legacy remains influential as a symbol of cross-cultural understanding, leaving an indelible mark on the history of China's engagement with the Western world.



## MacKillop

Mary MacKillop (1842-1909), a notable Australian nun, is renowned for co-founding the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart, a religious order committed to extending education and support to underprivileged children in Australia, with a particular focus on those in rural and remote regions. Her tireless dedication to expanding educational opportunities, especially for girls and Indigenous children, and her unwavering commitment to social justice, earned her the revered title of "Saint Mary of the Cross." Her enduring legacy persists as a symbol of resilience and compassion in improving the lives of marginalised individuals through education and community service.
