# Free student broadband offer extended

## **Main Points**

- The Australian Government announced an additional \$4.9 million in funding to NBN Co to extend
  the <u>School Student Broadband Initiative</u> (SSBI) to **30 June 2028** to ease cost-of-living pressures
  and narrow the digital divide for unconnected families with school-age children.
- The extension will allow the free service to continue for new and existing families, with up to 30,000 places available in the program.
- To apply, families and carers are encouraged to contact the National Referral Centre run by Anglicare Victoria on 1800 954 610 (10.00 am – 6.00 pm Monday to Friday) or visit <a href="https://www.anglicarevic.org.au/student-internet">www.anglicarevic.org.au/student-internet</a>.
- Posters and social media tiles can be downloaded from the NBN Co <u>Digital Asset Portal</u> to help promote the offer, with frequently asked questions also available.
